PLEASE READ AND SIGN THIS AGREEMENT

As Owner/Tenant of this property, I understand that I am responsible for payment of all fees and charges related to services rendered to the property and agree that service to the property is subject to compliance with the Rules Governing Water Service. I further understand and agree that the knowing submission of false information on this application can result in disconnection of water and wastewater services.

The District agrees to sell and deliver water to the Customer and the Customer agrees to purchase and receive in accordance with the Rules Governing Water Services as included in its approved Tariff on file at the District Office and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. Meters furnished, installed, owned and maintained by the District will measure all water. The meter and/or connection is for the sole use of the property, etc., without the specific written authorization of the District and in compliance with applicable rules and regulations.

The District has the right to locate a water service meter and the pipe necessary to connect the meter on the property of the Customer at a point mutually agreeable to both the District and Customer. The Customer will allow the District access at all reasonable times to its property and equipment located upon the Customer's premises for the limited purposes of reading the water meter, repairing or replacing existing facilities and to check for illegal connections or unsafe plumbing practices or cross-connections, in compliance with the requirements of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's "Rules and Regulations for Public Water Systems".

If the Customer has a grinder pump, Customer agrees to pay for the cost of maintaining a grinder pump. The District shall maintain and repair or replace such grinder pump and bill the customer by including the actual charges on the customer's utility bill.

The use of pipes and pipe fitting that contain more than 8.0% lead or solders and flux that contain more than 0.2% lead is prohibited for any plumbing installation or repair of any residential or non-residential facility providing water for human consumption and connected to the water supply.
