IMPORTANT NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

ONCE A WEEK WATER RESTRICTIONS HAVE BEEN IMPLEMENTED

Dear Resident:

Due to the continuing drought conditions in our area, on February 27, 2014, The Lower Colorado River Authority notified Travis County W.C.&I.D. #20 ("the District") that effective **March 1, 2014**, all LCRA water supply customers are required to limit outdoor watering to one day per week. Up until this date, residents and commercial customers of the District were allowed to water twice per week.

In an attempt to lessen confusion, the District's Board of Directors elected to discontinue the second day of watering and keep the first day the same as previously allowed.

The following outdoor watering schedule is now in effect:

Commercial Customers – (all addresses) - May water outdoors only on **Tuesday**

Odd-Numbered Addresses (addresses ending in odd numbers) – May water outdoors only on **Wednesday**

Even-Numbered Addresses (addresses ending in even numbers and "0") – May water outdoors only on **Thursday**

NOTE: All outside watering is prohibited from 10am to 7pm every day.

Pursuant to District Rules and Regulations, residents and commercial customers of the District who do not comply with this watering schedule are subject to monetary penalties. Chronic abusers may be subject to having their water service disconnected.
