

Lazy 9 MUDs Mandatory Outdoor Landscape Watering Guidelines

Effective 9/1/22

Lazy 9 MUDs 1A and 1B, (the “MUD’s”) are now under Stage 2 of their Drought Contingency Plan which sets forth rules pertaining to water usage. These MUDs buy water from the West Travis County Public Utility Agency, (WTCPUA) and the Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA). The WTCPUA and the LCRA contracts require the MUDs to enact the same level or more stringent level of water restrictions as those imposed by the WTCPUA and the LCRA.

Generally, Stage 2 restrictions include:

Areas with a hose-end sprinkler, in-ground irrigation system, soaker hose, or drip irrigation system shall be limited to no more than **TWICE** weekly on designated outdoor water use days and **only between the hours of 6PM and Midnight**.

- even-numbered street addresses: Thursday and Sunday
- odd-numbered street addresses: Wednesday and Saturday

Residents are allowed to water only between the hours of 6PM and Midnight.

Commercial watering is permitted on Tuesday and Friday.

If a **new landscape** has been installed within two weeks or after the initiation of Stage 2, then irrigation of that landscape may only occur during the outdoor watering hours listed immediately above and in accordance with the following 30 day irrigation schedule:

1. for the first 10-day after installation, once a day;
2. for day 11 through 20 after installation, once every other day; and
3. for day 21 through 30 after installation, once every third day.

Filling of pools is allowed only **between 6PM and Midnight** during the designated twice weekly schedule above for the particular address.

Compliance with this schedule is mandatory and violators will be subject to monetary penalties, as well as disconnection of water utilities.
