Because your District's wholesale water supplier, West Travis County Public Utility Agency initiated **Stage 2** Water Restrictions **Travis County MUD #18** is required to do the same.

Outdoor watering hours with an in-ground system or hose end sprinkler will be limited to between 7 a.m. – 10 a.m. & 7 p.m. – 10 p.m. ONE day per week.

Residential:

1 & 3 Monday

2 & 4 Tuesday

5& 7 Wednesday

6 & 8 Thursday

9 & 0 Friday

Commercial & HOA:

Saturday Only

<u>Please adjust irrigation schedules to follow the "one day per week" and "6am - 10 a.m.</u> <u>& 7 p.m. - 10 p.m." requirements.</u>

No overnight watering as we need customers to be able to monitor their irrigation and ensure there are no leaks or other water-wasting issues. This is vital as over-irrigation is causing our tanks to consistently get low resulting in low water pressure or no water for many customers. Please adjust your irrigation systems now to the new schedule, which is based on your address. We will be monitoring and enforcing this schedule.
